Teacher vacancies are up 38% from the previous year with 1,474 positions open at the start of the 2022-23 school year.

The newly elected Superintendent of Education, Ellen Weaver, ran on a campaign of "anti-wokeness" and "parents' rights" instead of on issues that affect teachers and students.
