By the Numbers

Since 2010, in South Carolina:



- ✓ Less than 15% of eligible voters participated in State Primaries. This determines who runs in the general election in November
- ✓ Less than 40% of eligible voters participated in Presidential Primaries
- ✓ Around 68% of eligible voters in SC participated in Presidential Elections (national average is 55%)
- ✓ Less than half of all eligible voters participate in off-year elections

What does this mean?

A candidate who can inspire turnout can win!

- ✗ Significant financial support or performing fundraising on behalf of a candidate
- ✗ Running the campaign (we encourage you to get a campaign manager to allow you to focus on being a *candidate!*)
- ✗ Providing extensive email lists, phone numbers, and addresses of voters (except in specific phone-banking or mailing activities)
